Loop-A-Ree is a spring camping opportunity for Cub Scout Packs in the Oconee District.

On Saturday the Tigers, Wolves and Bears will have fun earning Belt Loops of their choice. Most of the Belt Loops offered are those they are more difficult for small Packs to do alone. The Scouts will pick their 5 favorites and 2 alternates. Scouts will be assigned to sessions on a first-come, first serve basis. All the boys in your Den do not have to register for the same classes. If boys from the same Pack/Den register for the same class, the registration forms must be sent in together in order to try to place them in the same session. Also due to various class sizes we will not be able to guarantee Dens stay together but we will do our best.

Webelos will have special sessions concentrating on outdoor and camping skills. There will be a heavy focus on what to expect when you become a Boy Scout. These sessions will be run by Boys Scouts so it will be a great opportunity for your Webelos to meet and work with local Troops. Webelos Dens also need to register together in order to stay together.
